“Shramdaan” offered in Railway premises on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti

Maligtaon, 2nd October 2019. As a mark of respect to the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi on the auspicious occasion of his 150th birth anniversary, N F Railway, Construction Organisation launched special cleanliness drives “Shramdaan” today on 2nd October 2019 at Agthuri Railway station and Biodiversity Park, Amingaon. Sri N K Prasad, General Manager, N F Railway, Construction Organisation took led from the front in the “Shramdaan” campaign in which all the officers and a large number of employees and their family members also actively took part with great enthusiasm for cleanliness of the premises of Agthuri Railway station where special focus was given for collection of plastic. **To encourage the abandonment of plastic bags a few numbers of cotton bags were distributed among the people resided near by the station and Biodiversity Park .**

On the occasion Shri Prasad also planted a sapling in the premises of Biodiversity Park at Amingaon to convey the message of clean and green India. Following Shri Prasad other officers and employees also planted saplings at the Eco park .With those plantation the park will have now 1466 numbers trees out of which 1225 are new plants.

“Shramdaan” which is a part of “Swachhta hi Sewa” a fortnight programme to highlight the present swachhta campaign also a massive mass movement that seek to create clean India being undertaken throughout the country. **In this connection a documentary on Mahatma Gandhi was also screened to showcase the moral values of Gandhian philosophy.**

Later addressing the gathering Shri Prasad said that keeping cleanliness is not the responsibility only of safaikaramcharis or the government but of all the employees and Officers. Shri Prasad made appeal to employees, Officers and their family to implement the vision and philosophy behind Swachch Bharat Abhiyaan launched by the Prime Minister of India to abandon single used plastic and to maintain hygiene and sanitation in the railway premises.
